Resolution in favor of HB 3904 relating to the creation and continuation of a County Fire Marshal position

Whereas

Hidalgo County recognizes the State of Texas Local Government Code 352.011 Subchapter B is amended to establish the term of office for a county fire marshal for a period not to exceed four years; and

Whereas

currently the term of an appointed county fire marshal is two years; and

Whereas

the newly amended update would align with county elected official terms and helps 254 counties in the State of Texas that have appointed a county fire marshal; and

Whereas


this would provide stability and consistency for the office of a county Fire Marshal.


