WHEREAS, throughout his educational and professional career, Ramirez has demonstrated an interest in public and community service, including promoting youth civic engagement as well as volunteering and working for candidates for political office; Ramirez also worked in a public capacity in our very own Hidalgo County local government, having served as Hidalgo County's Public Affairs Specialist in the Hidalgo County Judge's Office - Public Affairs Division; and

WHEREAS, Ramirez is presently Director of Communications and Public Relations for La Joya Independent School District where he directs all communication mediums within the district and serves as the public figure representing La Joya ISD and its interests within the local community and the state; and




