

**RESOLUTION IN HONOR OF HIDALGO COUNTY BRIGHT SPOTS IN HISPANIC EDUCATION**

**WHEREAS**, in commemoration of the White House Initiative on Educational Excellence for Hispanics 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary, over 230 programs, models, and organizations were selected as Bright Spots in Hispanic Education to highlight the tremendous progress Latinos are making in education; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 15, 2015 during the Hispanic Heritage Month celebration at the White House in Washington D.C. , the Bright Spots in Education were announced including three programs in Hidalgo County; and


