

ORDINANCE NO. 5172

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A RUNOFF ELECTION IN MISSION, TEXAS PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL PLACE 1; PROVIDING FOR POLLING PLACES AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING TO SAID ELECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to the requirement of Article 3 of the Charter of the City of Mission and Ordinance No. 2250, an election was called to be held in the City of Mission, Texas, on the first Saturday, in May, 2022, the same being the Seventh (7) of May, 2022, for the purpose of electing Mayor and Councilmembers for Places One, and Three for the City of Mission, Texas.

SECTION 2: The majority of votes was not received by any one candidate for Mayor and City Council Place 1.

SECTION 3: A runoff election is called for the second Saturday in June, 2022 the same being the 11th day of June 2022 for the purpose of determining a winner for Mayor and City Council Place 1.

SECTION 4: Every qualified voter who desires to cast an early vote and expects to be absent on the day of said election, or is otherwise entitled to vote early under the provisions of the applicable statutes of the State of Texas, shall upon proper application be entitled to an official ballot and the right to cast such ballot in accordance with the early voting laws of the State of Texas, particularly Title 7, Texas Election Code.

Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted by the County of Hidalgo Elections Administrator. Early Voting will be held at the following locations and times:

- Mission Parks & Recreation Gym, 721 N. Bryan Road
- Mission Boys & Girls Club Gym at Bannworth Park, 1822 N. Shary Road

Tuesday, May 31, 2022 – 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.

Wednesday, June 1, 2022 – 8 a.m. – 6 p.m.

Thursday, June 2, 2022 – 8 a.m. – 6 p.m.

Friday, June 3, 2022 – 8 a.m. – 6 p.m.

Saturday, June 4, 2022 – 8 a.m. – 6 p.m.

Sunday, June 5, 2022 - CLOSED

Monday, June 6, 2022 – 8 a.m. – 6 p.m.

Tuesday, June 7, 2022 – 7 a.m. 7 p.m.

Applications for early ballots to be voted by mail shall be made to Early Voting Clerk, Yvonne Ramon Elections Administrator, P.O. Box 659, 213 S. Closner Blvd., Edinburg, TX 78540-0659 or her designated assistant who shall conduct the early voting in said election in the manner prescribed by the applicable statutes of the State of Texas. The period for accepting applications for early ballots to be voted by mail for the Runoff General Election is hereby scheduled through June 6, 2022.

SECTION 5: The City of Mission will have four city wide polling locations on Election Day as follows:

- Castro Elementary School Cafeteria, 200 S. Mayberry
- Mission High School, 1802 W. 18th
- Mission Boys & Girls Club Gym at Bannworth Park, 1822 N. Shary Rd.
- Mission Parks & Recreation Gym, 721 N. Bryan Road

SECTION 6: The polls at each Municipal Voting location shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on June 11, 2022.

SECTION 7: The City Secretary is hereby directed to give notice of said election by posting said notice at the City Hall and to give notice by publication and otherwise as required by law.
